





Staircase terminology made easy

Below is a diagram and list of words we commonly use to describe the various elements of your staircase – it will be useful to know these when discussing your project.







10mm Embedded Glass

Embedded glass offers simple style with clean, defined lines and elegant beauty. It is exquisite when paired with carpeted treads and an enhanced grip feature oak step with warm oak tones to invite visitors up the stairway. This sleek, streamlined look eliminates the need for clamps, whilst the 10mm toughened safety glass leaves the stairway feeling light and open, ensuring safety is never compromised.

10mm Clamped Glass

For those wishing to add a touch more detail than an embedded glass balustrade, brass or steel clamps (see page 45) can be used to secure our 10mm glass in position. Clamps are often selected to match door furniture or other fixtures and fittings to add a feeling of continuity between your staircase and the rest of your home.








15mm Frameless Glass

The cutting edge style of frameless glass requires design and installation expertise at every stage, but results in a spectacular centrepiece to a home with an ultra-modern interior. A beautiful new oak staircase with enhanced grip oak treads houses a frameless glass balustrade eliminating the need for handrails and newel posts altogether. Unlike standard balustrade glass, frameless glass requires a thicker profile to compensate for the strength which would otherwise be provided by the timber posts and rails. Precision drilling prior to the toughening process is also required to allow an alternative and secure fitting method.









Optiwhite™ Low Iron Glass

If you thought all balustrade glass was the same, think again. Striving to be at the forefront of staircase design and innovation since 1996, Abbott-Wade were the first to market with Optiwhite™ low-iron balustrade glass. Unlike other glass which inherently has a green cast, Optiwhite™ is practically colourless.

Manufactured by Pilkington Glass, one of the leading glass suppliers in the UK and the market leaders in glass technology, Optiwhite™ low iron glass is an excellent choice for glass staircases where the edges are visible and where transparency and purity of colour are often desired. Customers who have selected new Optiwhite™ as opposed to traditional glass for its neutral qualities have been thrilled with the results.



Split-Level Living

Because homes and staircases come in all shapes and sizes, split-level living is often a solution which eliminates the need for separate rooms and allows safe split-level living areas while maintaining an open plan style. Refurbishing this balustrading with glass is very popular and a great way to enhance the feeling of openness, though traditional or contemporary spindles are also a viable option.










Sandblasted Glass

Translucent sandblasted glass is available in both our standard glass or Optiwhite™ low-iron glass and provides an opaque finish, which is perfect for those wishing to bring more light into a space without fully transparent glass. The panels can be secured into oak rails with stainless-steel clamps or embedded into the rails. The pictured examples include a mitred return at the top of the stairs to allow a standard 90mm post to support the rake and landing balustrades without the need for an oversized or additional newel while pyramid newel caps add extra detail for the eye.





Bronzed Glass

Bronzed glass is a warming opaque alternative to traditional glass. The usual design rule of 'glass is for looking through, not looking at' doesn't apply here. Aesthetically pleasing, the gold tinged hue of bronzed glass pairs perfectly with brass glass clamps and the reflective properties at the correct angles can open up a stairway and complement other decor.

Shaped Glass

For the perfect fit our bespoke glass staircases can be cut to follow the contours of existing stair treads, regardless of how uneven they may be. This is an ideal solution if you like the look of a glass balustrade but have a traditional cut string staircase. We also shape glass to suit other situations including diminishing handrails or filling triangular sections in oak handrails.










Glass Spindles



Designed and brought to market by the team at Abbott-Wade, this contemporary look is ideal for those wishing to achieve the purity of clean lines as there is no need for brackets. Glass spindles offer the same benefits of embedded glass, emphasising light and space with the sleek lines of embedded glass but with additional detail of the exposed edges of the spaced spindles to add a crystal-like sparkle. Tailor made to your specific dimensions, glass spindles are a truly bespoke option.











White & Glass Staircases

A modern, minimalist look using a stylish combination of pristine white pre-finished wood and glass that is fresh and clean. This ultra-cool design is guaranteed to brighten up even the darkest of hallways to give the illusion of more light and space. Paired with stunning décor like contemporary white and neutrals, a white finished staircase would be the icing on the cake for any contemporary styled home.







Combining oak with painted white timber & glass

Combining oak with painted white timber is a design styling which works on two levels. For the aesthetically minded stair designer, the contrasting colour tones complement each other magnificently, with the warmth of the oak combining with the pristine brilliance of the white, especially when incorporating glass into the balustrade.

For the pragmatists amongst us, the elegant white timber can be incorporated into the ornate parts of the staircase such as the spindles, apron and stringers whilst the handrail and newel cap which receive the most wear and tear, are manufactured in hardwearing oak which is less susceptible to scuffs and scratches. What's more, because all our staircases are bespoke, the final combination is entirely in your hands.





Bespoke Colours


All Abbott-Wade staircases come pre-finished, regardless of whether a clear lacquer, paint or bespoke stain is preferred.


Polished Stainless Steel

Staircase scientists would probably claim that combining materials such as oak, steel and glass can often culminate in a stunning staircase greater than the sum of it's parts. We would be strongly inclined to agree. Glass and chrome, whether polished or brushed, adds a very clean, modern style which can be softened by the warmer tones of oak. A further bespoke twist could involve using any one of our special stains such as the black Onyx stained oak photographed here.



Brushed Stainless Steel

Set in a luxury spa against a striking stone feature wall, this Abbott-Wade contemporary brushed stainless steel and glass balustrade (pictured above) exudes modern luxury. The defined lines and textures of the steel and glass are softened by the warm tones of handsome walnut stairs to create an awe inspiring combination. The stylish string-mounted stainless steel baluster posts house 10mm toughened glass to ensure that visitors remain safe whilst being spellbound on the stairway!


Customise your balustrade with square or round profile rails or you can combine your stainless steel balustrade with your own choice of hardwood whatever the size and layout of your staircase.

Walnut

A rich chocolate-brown wood that's composed of straight grain, with a fine even texture. Walnut timber is tough, strong and very easily worked with. The timber can be machined and finished precisely whilst taking polish extremely well.

Walnut has been used historically for high end furniture and interior timber products due to its value. Considered a premium domestic hardwood, this timber is favoured for use in contrast with lighter colours.









Feature Steps

A feature step is the ultimate invitation to explore your new staircase and can be finished in natural oak or with a stylish carpet. A step can say a great deal about the personality of your staircase. It can be a flamboyantly grand or understated and can be added to a staircase renovation or incorporated into the design of your new flight. A feature step can also alter the position of the first newel post creating much more room. An Abbott-Wade staircase will give your stairs the Wow-Factor while a new feature step will add some additional awe.



Maximising a small staircase

You don't need a grand house to have a staircase that makes a statement. Our friendly installations team travels to homes of all shapes and sizes throughout the country. One thing that is consistent is the level of transformation a staircase renovation can achieve.

We've installed some grand staircases over the years but the best things can often come in small packages. Many of the family homes we visit may only consist of two and a half newel posts, or in the case of the King family, only one post with no landing balustrade at all.

The staircase in this family home used only one newel post at the foot of the stairs with tired ranch rails which encroached over the treads up to a baton at the top of the stairs which narrowed the walkway.

The Abbott-Wade team designed cleverly angled toughened glass to diminish into the ceiling to maximise space on the stairway and add sparkle and light into a small space. A wall handrail was added to ensure that the family now have a safe handhold as they ascend and descend the stairs. For added character, a new feature step now invites visitors to climb the stairs from the hallway and bright, bold décor helps to emphasis light and complement the oak rails.


When a standard staircase is not a viable design because space is at an absolute premium, Abbott-Wade's innovative space saving paddle stairs may be the best option. Our ingeniously constructed paddle stairs allow a sharper pitch than a normal staircase and are also not only functional but sleek and stylish too.











Forged Steel Spindles

Abbott-Wade's wrought iron effect forged steel spindles add an air of distinction to any staircase and pair exquisitely when interspacing hardwoods like oak, walnut and sapele. To add to its versatility, our forged steel spindles come in a range of styles and can be finished in a bespoke colour for those wishing to make a more unique design statement.


















Even though all our staircases are bespoke and made to meet the specifications of the home we are working in, some staircases are a little more bespoke than others!

The staircase design which perhaps requires the most knowledge and expertise to produce is the helical staircase.

Transforming an existing helical staircase requires precision made components due to the truly unique nature of this type of staircase. Even the slightest error of only a couple of millimetres when producing the materials for your helical staircase design could be disastrous to the entire installation. Thankfully, this is where Abbott-Wade's expertise and experience from over 20 years in the industry comes in very handy!









THE MANUFACTURING PROCESS

The precise curves of a helical staircases means the design and manufacturing process requires a level of skill, expertise and precision beyond that needed for a straight staircase. A comprehensive digital site survey is taken using state of the art measuring technology that is accurate to within 80 microns to capture the precise details of any underlying construction.

This is used to create a detailed 3-dimensional digital CAD model by a highly skilled design team to allow for the meticulous manufacture of curved components or a complete bespoke helical staircase. This is achieved by dividing the more complex curves and features into parts and running them through a computer simulation to make sure that each component is correct and accurate. These accurate models allow skilled craftsmen to build a forma which duplicates the exact curvature required around which the curved components are built.
















Sleek-Twist Spindles




Stop Chamfered Spindles and Newels






The Id Range






EZ - A slender spindle with opposing cut-outs on each side, the EZ has a hint of art deco and the paradox of a modern spindle with a slightly retro feel.

A touch of 21st century charisma can also be added to a traditional oak staircase with bespoke fluting to add elegant vertically crafted features to your staircase.














Continuous Handrail

1. Design Consultation

Upon contacting us we'll make an appointment for a home visit at your convenience. The average visit doesn't take long but we are, of course, happy to stay as long as required to ensure you have all the information you need. 2. Detailed Survey

Once you've placed your order, our surveyor will visit and take the detailed final measurements. This is also an opportunity to ask any technical questions you may have and clarify any aspects of your order. 3. Installation

Finally, our installations team will visit to complete the installation working under a canopy outside the property to complete any messier cutting. If you've ordered a new flight, the old staircase will be removed and taken away for recycling and the new stairs installed.



If we're renovating your stairs we'll remove and replace your existing newel posts and balustrading and complete any other work you may have specified such as cladding over the stringers or treads. What's more, as all your new stair parts are installed pre-finished, there's usually no need for a return visit by decorators or French polishers.



Decision making process:


A large national company quoted more than twice what I eventually paid for the same product. When I found Abbott-Wade they were not only better value but had the advantage of years of experience.

Decision making process:



The style we were wanting to create was modern and contemporary and for the staircase to relate to our style throughout the whole of our home.


